

SCHEDULE

Friday 14 September, approximately noon: clues released online and/or via email.

Saturday 15 September, 8:00 AM: Mandatory flight briefing, KSAF [LOCATION TBD].

Saturday 15 September, 12:30 PM: Post-flight check in with the 99s, KSAF.

Saturday 15 September, approximately 2:00 PM: Revelation of treasures and presentation of awards.

Rain date: Sunday 16 September. Notice of postponement will be posted online and by e-mail to registered pilots Friday 14 September, no later than 8:00 p.m. MDT.

SAFETY FIRST!

Pilots are responsible for making their own go/no-go decisions.
All flights must be conducted under Visual Flight Rules.
All FAA rules and regulations must be adhered to.
Any violation of these rules may result in immediate disqualification.

EARNING POINTS

The goal is to earn as many points as possible within the allotted flight time by identifying and photographing the most treasures. Ties will be settled by a coin toss. Treasures must be identified on the clue sheet (be specific), photographed, and marked on the sectional chart. To aid the judges, please specify on the clue sheet the order in which the photographs were taken. Judges' decisions will be final.

TEAMS

An air team is comprised of one aircraft, one pilot in command, and one photographer. Additional passengers are allowed. A team may obtain assistance solving the clues from any source.

Each pilot must be registered for the treasure hunt.

Each team must provide its own sectional chart and digital camera with a view screen. The first photo must include the pilot and aircraft with N-number visible, taken the morning of the treasure hunt before the flight.

THE FLIGHT

Photographs must be made from the air on the morning of the Treasure Hunt. Although the photographs don't have to be from directly overhead, the treasures must be easily identifiable. If the clue is an airport, runway numbers must be readable.

For safety, pilots should announce their arrival in the vicinity of each treasure on the air-to-air frequency, 122.75, by stating "[N number] at treasure number ___", as printed on the clue sheet (NOT the photo order number).

If circling is necessary, make RIGHT traffic around treasures.
